

December 7, 2016 CCSWC District Meeting "Caloosahatchee River Issues and Opportunities"

The Charlotte County Soil and Water Conservation District is hosting a meeting **December 7, 2016 starting at 5:15 p.m.** to discuss opportunities while providing information that may result in improved water quality, increased water storage, and other auxiliary benefits within the Caloosahatchee River Watershed Basin. The meeting will be held at **the UF/IFAS Charlotte County Extension Service, 25550 Harbor View Road, Port Charlotte, FL 33980.**

The subject area that will be discussed contains: two water Districts (South Florida Water Management District and Southwest Florida Water Management District), multiple counties including: Lee, Charlotte, Glades, Hendry, and DeSoto); a number of cities; and is within the jurisdiction of many Federal, State, and Local Agencies. Key presenters will be discussing issues, potential funding, best management practices, and other key components of the initiative. At the end of the meeting there will be a panel discussion by the presenters to answer questions and obtain feedback from the participating audience. The Charlotte County Soil and Water Conservation District will be seeking input and ideas from everyone attending the meeting.
