4pm – 6pm Cambier Park rally and issues discussion

Service Learning hours opportunities include:

1. Event promotion through social media (variable time assignment)
2. Lecture planning and materials assembly (variable time assignment)
3. Signs planning and supplies assembly (variable time assignment)
4. Food & water organizing and logistics (variable time assignment)
5. Sign assembly (1 hour)
6. Lecture & discussion session participation (1.5 hours)
7. Video and photo documentation of events (in parallel with other activities)
8. Street corner public outreach (3 hours)
9. Transit time and table setup at Cambier Park rally (1 hour)
10. Cambier Park rally participation (2 hours)
11. Post-event video editing and production (variable time assignment)

Activities #4-#10 can all be performed on Nov 4 from 10am to 6pm for a total of 8 service learning hours. Additional hours are available before and after Nov 4 through activities #1-#3 and #11.
