Colonel Alfred A. Pantano, Jr. will assume command of the Jacksonville District on July 24, 2009.

Colonel Pantano is a recent student at the United States Army War College at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania. Prior to this assignment, he served as the Chief of Staff of the United States Army Engineer School at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. COL Pantano commanded the 94th Engineer Combat Battalion (Heavy) in Germany, Iraq, and at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He is responsible for transforming the 94 ECB (H) to a modular structure and reassigning it from Germany to Fort Leonard Wood as part of the Army's Global Rebasement and Restationing Initiative.
