The Lee County League of Women Voters will meet Saturday, November 5, 2016 at The Helm Club at The Landings. Breakfast will be at 9:00 a.m. and the meeting will begin at 9:30. Speaker for the event will be Wayne E. Daltry, long known in Southwest Florida as one who cares deeply about the preservation of a healthy environment. His topic will be "To Build or Not to Build". •

Density Reduction, Groundwater Resource (DRGR) is a designation granted by Lee County for certain environmentally-rich areas that should be protected from excessive development. Mr. Daltry will speak about how the designation came to be and how areas have been identified for the designation. Such areas are often found attractive by developers and by industries such as mining. It then becomes the responsibility of county officials to decide whether or not to allow exceptions to the DRGR rules.

Mr. Daltry has a bachelor's degree from the Citadel and a Masters in Planning Program from Florida State University. His entire career has been devoted to finding the balance between preserving the environment and serving the growth needs of an ever-increasing population. He served for twenty years as executive director of the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council and has been active in countless organizations which are concerned with smart growth.
